VOLUNTEER FIRE CAPACITY PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY AND FIRE PROTECTION

STATE OF CALIFORNIA Natural Resources Agency

Agreement for the Volunteer Fire Capacity Program of the Cooperative Forestry Assistance Act of 1978

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered between the STATE of California, acting through the Director of the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection hereinafter called "STATE", and ZAYANTE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT hereinafter called "LOCAL AGENCY", covenants as follows:

RECITALS:

- 1. STATE has been approved as a passthrough agent of the United States Department of Agriculture, (USDA), Forest Service for the purpose of administering the Volunteer Fire Capacity program in California, hereinafter referred to as VFC, authorized by the Cooperative Forestry Assistance Act (CFAA) of 1978 (PL 95-313, 92 Stat 365, 16 U.S.C. 2106), as amended.
- 2. This is a subaward under the 2024 Volunteer Fire Capacity Grant #24-DG-11052012-161 awarded to STATE by the Forest Service on August 23, 2024. The Federal Assistance Listing for the award is 10.698, Cooperative Forestry Program. This subaward is funded solely with Federal funds and is subject to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) guidance in subparts A through F of 2 CFR Part 200, as adopted and supplemented by the USDA in 2 CFR Part 400, and under certain terms and conditions to LOCAL AGENCY to assist LOCAL AGENCY to upgrade its fire protection capability.
- 3. LOCAL AGENCY desires to participate in said VFC and agrees to the terms and conditions specified in the Procedural Guide for Volunteer Fire Capacity Program 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

- 4. <u>APPROVAL</u>: This Agreement is of no force or effect until signed by both parties and approved by the Department of General Services, if required. LOCAL AGENCY may not commence performance until such approval has been obtained.
- 5. <u>INCORPORATION</u>: The Procedural Guide for Volunteer Fire Capacity Program 2024, submitted Application for Funding and associated Grant Assurances are hereby incorporated by reference as part of the Grant Agreement.
- 6. <u>TIMELINESS</u>: Time is of the essence in this Agreement.
- 7. <u>FORFEITURE OF AWARD</u>: LOCAL AGENCY must return this Agreement and required resolution properly signed and executed to STATE at the email address specified in paragraph 12, with a timestamp no later than December 1, 2024 or LOCAL AGENCY will forfeit the funds.

8. <u>GRANT AND BUDGET CONTIGENCY CLAUSE</u>: It is mutually understood between the parties that this **Agreement** may have been written for the mutual benefit of both parties before ascertaining the availability of congressional appropriation of funds, to avoid program and fiscal delays that would occur if the **Agreement** were executed after that determination was made.

This **Agreement** is valid and enforceable only if sufficient funds are made available to the STATE by the United States Government for the **State Fiscal Year 2024** for the purpose of this program. In addition, this **Agreement** is subject to any additional restrictions, limitations, or conditions enacted by the Congress or to any statute enacted by the Congress that may affect the provisions, terms, or funding of this **Agreement** in any manner.

The parties mutually agree that if the Congress does not appropriate sufficient funds for the program, this **Agreement** shall be amended to reflect any reduction in funds.

The STATE has the option to invalidate the **Agreement** under the 30-day cancellation clause or to amend the **Agreement** to reflect any reduction in funds.

- 9. <u>REIMBURSEMENT</u>: STATE will reimburse LOCAL AGENCY, from funds made available to STATE by the Federal Government, an amount not to exceed \$4,373.76 on a 50/50 matching funds basis, for the performance of specific projects and/or purchase of specific items identified in Proposed Project, Application for Funding, attached hereto. Reimbursement will be only for those projects accomplished and/or items purchased between THE LAST SIGNATORY DATE ON PAGE 1 and JUNE 30, 2025. This sum is the sole and maximum payment that STATE will make pursuant to this Agreement. LOCAL AGENCY must bill STATE at the e-mail address specified in paragraph 12, with a timestamp no later than September 1, 2025 in order to receive the funds. The bill submitted by LOCAL AGENCY must clearly delineate the projects performed and/or items purchased. A vendor's invoice and proof of payment to vendor(s) must be included for items purchased.
- 10. <u>LIMITATIONS</u>: Expenditure of the funds distributed by STATE herein is subject to the same limitations as placed by the VFC, upon expenditure of United States Government Funds. Pursuant to 2CFR200.313 Equipment, subject to the obligations and conditions set forth in that section; title to any equipment and supplies acquired under this **Agreement** vests with the LOCAL AGENCY. For any equipment items over \$5,000, the federal government may retain a vested interested in accordance with paragraph 17 below.
- 11. <u>MATCHING FUNDS</u>: Any and all funds paid to LOCAL AGENCY under the terms of this **Agreement**, hereinafter referred to as "VFC Funds", shall be matched by LOCAL AGENCY on a dollar-for-dollar basis, for each project listed on attachment(s) hereto identified as "Proposed Project". No amount of unpaid "contributed" or "volunteer" labor or services shall be used or consigned in calculating the matching amount "actually spent" by LOCAL AGENCY.

LOCAL AGENCY shall not use VFC Funds as matching funds for other federal grants, including Department of Interior (USDI) Rural Fire Assistance grants, nor use funds from other federal grants, including USDI Rural Fire Assistance grants, as matching funds for VFC Funds.

- 13. <u>PURPOSE</u>: Any project to be funded hereunder must be intended to specifically assist LOCAL AGENCY to organize, train, and/or equip local firefighting forces in the aforementioned rural area and community to prevent or suppress fires which threaten life, resources, and/or improvements within the area of operation of LOCAL AGENCY. Project funds are not to be used for research and development.
- 14. <u>COMBINING</u>: In the event funds are paid for two or more separate, but closely related projects, the 50/50 cost-sharing formula will be applied to the total cost of such combined projects.
- 15. <u>OVERRUNS</u>: In the event that the total cost of a funded project exceeds the estimate of costs upon which this Agreement is made, LOCAL AGENCY may request additional funds to cover the **Agreement** share of the amount exceeded. However, there is no assurance that any such funds are, or may be, available for reimbursement. Any increase in funding will require an amendment.
- 16. <u>UNDERRUNS</u>: In the event that the total cost of a funded project is less than the estimate of costs upon which this **Agreement** is made, LOCAL AGENCY may request that additional eligible projects/items be approved by STATE for **Agreement** funding. However, there is no assurance that any such approval will be funded. Approval of additional projects/items, not listed on the Proposed Project application, made by STATE, will be in writing and will require an amendment.
- 17. <u>FEDERAL INTEREST IN EQUIPMENT</u>: The Federal Government has a vested interest in any item purchased with VFC funding in excess of \$5,000 regardless of the length of this **Agreement**, until such time as the fair market value is less than \$5,000. The VFC percentage used to purchase the equipment will be applied to the sale price and recovered for the Government during the sale. This percentage will remain the same even following depreciation. The Federal Government may not have to be reimbursed if the disposal sale amounts to a fair market value of less than \$5,000. LOCAL AGENCY will notify STATE of the disposal of such items.

- 18. <u>EQUIPMENT INVENTORY</u>: Any single item purchased in excess of \$5,000 will be assigned an VFC Property Number by the STATE. LOCAL AGENCY shall forward a copy of the purchase documents listing the item, brand, model, serial number, any LOCAL AGENCY property number assigned, and a LOCAL AGENCY contact and return address to STATE at the address specified in paragraph 12. The STATE will advise the LOCAL AGENCY Contact of the VFC Property Number assigned.
- 19. <u>AUDIT</u>: LOCAL AGENCY agrees that the STATE, the Department of General Services, the Bureau of State Audits, or their designated representative shall have the right to review and to copy any records and supporting documentation pertaining to the performance of this Agreement. LOCAL AGENCY agrees to maintain such records for possible audit for a minimum of five (5) years after final payment, unless a longer period of records retention is stipulated. LOCAL AGENCY agrees to allow the auditor(s) access to such records during normal business hours and to allow interviews of any employees who might reasonably have information related to such records. Further, LOCAL AGENCY agrees to include a similar right of the State of California to audit records and interview staff in any subcontract related to performance of this Agreement. (GC 8546.7, PCC 10115 et seq., CCR Title 2, Section 1896).
- 20. <u>DISPUTES</u>: In the event of any dispute over qualifying matching expenditures of LOCAL AGENCY or audit findings, the dispute will be decided by STATE and its decision shall be final and binding.
- 21. <u>MONITORING</u>: LOCAL AGENCY agrees to the monitoring of activities as necessary by STATE to ensure that the award is used for authorized purposes, in compliance with Federal statutes, regulations, and the terms and conditions of the agreement; and that performance goals are achieved.
- 22. <u>INDEMNIFICATION</u>: LOCAL AGENCY agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless, the STATE, its officers, agents, and employees, from any and all claims and losses, accruing or resulting to any and all contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, laborers, and any other person, firm or corporation furnishing or supplying work services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of this **Agreement**, and from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm or corporation who may be injured or damaged by LOCAL AGENCY in the performance of this **Agreement**.
- 23. <u>CIVIL RIGHTS</u>: LOCAL AGENCY agrees to comply with civil rights requirements as detailed in the Complying With Civil Rights Requirements brochure (FS-850) and the And Justice For All poster (AD-475A). The poster is to be placed at all public point of contact/reception areas.
- 24. <u>DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE REQUIREMENTS</u>: LOCAL AGENCY will comply with the requirements of the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1990 and will provide a drug-free workplace by taking the following actions:
 - a. Publish a statement notifying employees that unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession or use of a controlled substance is prohibited and specifying actions to be taken against employees for violations.
 - b. Establish a Drug-Free Awareness Program to inform employees about:

- 1) the dangers of drug abuse in the workplace;
- 2) the person's or organization's policy of maintaining a drugfree workplace;
- 3) any available counseling, rehabilitation and employee assistance programs; and,
- 4) penalties that may be imposed upon employees for drug abuse violations.
- c. Every employee who works on the proposed Agreement will:
 - 1) receive a copy of the company's drug-free workplace policy statement; and,
 - 2) agree to abide by the terms of the company's statement as a condition of employment on the Agreement.

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in suspension of payments under the **Agreement** or termination of the **Agreement** or both and LOCAL AGENCY may be ineligible for funding of any future State **Agreement** if the department determines that any of the following has occurred: (1) the LOCAL AGENCY has made false certification, or violated the certification by failing to carry out the requirements as noted above. (GC 8350 et seq.)

25. <u>TERM</u>: The term of the Agreement SHALL COMMENCE ON THE LAST SIGNATORY DATE ON PAGE 1 and continue through June 30, 2025.

- 26. <u>TERMINATION</u>: This Agreement may be terminated by either party giving 30 days written notice to the other party or provisions herein amended upon mutual consent of the parties hereto.
- 27. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>: No amendment or variation of the terms of this **Agreement** shall be valid unless made in writing, signed by the parties and approved as required. No oral understanding or **Agreement** not incorporated in the **Agreement** is binding on any of the parties.
- 28. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR</u>: LOCAL AGENCY, and the agents and employees of LOCAL AGENCY, in the performance of this **Agreement**, shall act in an independent capacity and not as officers or employees or agents of the STATE or the Federal Government.
- 29. <u>INDIRECT RATE</u>: LOCAL AGENCY may not assess an indirect rate in excess of their Federally approved Negotiated Indirect Cost Rate Agreement (NICRA), a de minimis rate if LOCAL AGENCY does not have an approved NICRA, or the VFC program cap rate of 10%, whichever is lesser. LOCAL AGENCY may also elect not to assess an indirect rate. The approved indirect cost rate at the time of execution is 0%.

30. <u>MEDIA</u>: LOCAL AGENCY shall acknowledge STATE and USDA Forest Service support in any publications, audiovisuals and electronic media developed as a result of this award.

It is encouraged to give public notice of the receipt of this award and announce progress and accomplishments, acknowledging STATE and USDA Forest Service support. Follow direction in USDA Supplemental 2 CFR 415.2.

31. <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: This Agreement is not assignable by LOCAL AGENCY either in whole or in part.

Zayante Fire Protection District – SHSGP ZENSS Project

Extract :

The Zayante Fire Protection District is requesting funding to complete the Outdoor Warning Siren project. This body approved phase 2 in grant cycle FY 2024-2025 for installation in the Lompico Canyon. This request addresses the final phase in the Notification Network through installation in the Upper Zayante Canyon.

A District wide Zayante Emergency Notification Siren System (ZENSS) is a public safety priority in order to add a critical public safety layer of emergency notification redundancy, primarily for those who are outdoors, off grid, without power or connectivity to landline, VOIP phone, cellular services and cable television. Sirens will be placed strategically through the Distict as available funding is secured to ensure maximum coverage of audible alerts when the sirens are activated. The CZU wildfire, Lahaina wildfire and 2023 Atmospheric River Disaster events expose the need for a greater resilience in our communications and alert and warning systems. The Zayante Fire District is requesting SCHGP funding from the Gang of Five Committee in the amount of \$60,796.87 for one location. This project will focus on community alert and warning in the Upper Zayante Canyon to provide early warning from wildfire. The community of 600 residents is flanked by Very High Fire Severity protected Sand Parkland habitat and Watershed Timber lands with poor access limiting early suppression intervention. Funding assistance is requested to complete this project due to limited public funding of the Fire District and a low community capacity to self-fund the project. According to the 2017-2021 American Community Survey (ACS), a majority of Lompico and Zayante residents are low-income. In addition, the per capita income for a Lompico resident is \$53,054 and Zayante has the highest poverty rate for any CDP (Census Designated Place) in Santa Cruz County @ 21.1%. Further, 48.3% of female household families with no spouses in Zayante are living in poverty.

Discussion :

The ZENSS Outdoor warning sirens are intended for outdoor alerting and there is no guarantee they will be heard indoors, depending on sound insulation of structures, as well as the distance from the sirens and surrounding terrain necessitating the network overlap of siren coverage.

Many agencies throughout the United States have outdoor warning systems to alert the public of potential dangers in a short amount of time. For example, numerous Cities and Counties in the Mid Western United States have siren systems to warn of severe weather events such as tornadoes or thunderstorms. Some coastal cities in Hawaii, Alaska and California have siren systems to warn of Tsunami's. Several California municipalities use siren systems for all risk alerting.

The Zayante Fire Protection District has maintained an Outdoor Siren System at its main Station since the 1950's primarily as an alert and notification signal for volunteer firefighters to respond for an emergency. In the 1980's the siren was used to notify residents of approaching « Medfly » spraying operations and again in the early 2000's for aerial spraying.

Once approved and funded, the sirens will provide a key tool in the District's alert and warning toolkit to notify this rural community of the need for emergency action resilent to power and communication outages.

The District benefits from an existing warning toolkit including :

- Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS) with an Emergency Alert System and Wireless Emergency Alerts. (CRUZAWARE)
- Radio KSCO 1080 AM
- Television KSBW 8
- Social Media postings
- PA systems and vehicle sirens.

The existing Alert systems requires connectivity and a power supply to be effective. During PGE Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) and recently in the 2023 Atmospheric River Disaster in Santa Cruz County significant communities within the Fire District experienced lengthy periods of time often weeks without power from PG&E. During extended wildfire and wind driven events it is anticipated the utility grid will be shut down. Without power local Comcast and AT&T phone systems failed due to expired battery backup systems. The utility failures denied access to common sources of information such as the Internet, phone systems and cable television. The information black-out had a material affect on residents who needed to drive to local fire stations to summon emergency medical aid or report incidents. Many residents isolated and stranded by landslides were directly disenfranchised from the Social Safety network.

Implementation :

The preliminary location and number of sirens has be determined by sound propogation testing within the community to provide sufficient coverage while recognizing the need to reduce sound carring over to neighboring communities to avoid misinterpretation.

An initial test(s) will include community messaging in advance to advertise and engage community members to respond via social medial to the quality of sound propogation. Coined « Siren Saturdays » we will be able to forecast sound propogation from Fire Station 1's existing ZENSS. Based on resident feedback we can project the need to install a ZENNS siren in Lompico and an additional ZENSS siren in Upper Zayante focused on concentrated populations.

Lompico is a target community as it exists within a box canyon with a single road access for entry and exit for a resident population of approximately 1500. Efforts since 2019 to establish an emergency access alternate road have been unsuccesful to date.

SHSGP funding for FY2024/25 approved one installation from this body for a Lompico Canyon Installation.

The Upper Zayante community is the final critical target location due primarily due to the frequency and length of power outages experienced year after year and the remoteness of the community and completes the notification network designed to overlap the community. The distance from emergency services infers lengthy response times of 20-30 minutes in most instances.

Deployment is anticipated to involve installation on publicly owned or public right of way properties. It is anticipated a collaboration with the Zayante Fire Protection District, San Lorenzo Valley Water District and County of Santa Cruz will be necessary to effect successful results. Partnerships with the community at large, PG&E and grant funding solutions are necessary components to completion of the project.

Environmental Impact :

In review of existing systems with respect to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) we believe the project qualifies for an exemption for specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. Pub. Res. Code Sec. 21080(b)(4). The sirens would serve to warn residents of an emergency situation in a very high fire hazard area, as well as needed for other environmental emergencies deemed appropriate, and thus would aid in mitigating an emergency.

« Emergency means a sudden, unexpected occurrence, involving a clear and imminent danger, demanding immediate action to prevent or mitigate loss of, or damage to, life, health, property, or essential public services. « Emergency includes occurances such as fire, flood, earthquakes, or other soil or geological movements. (Public Res. Code Sec. 21060.5).

Further, depending on final design, the project may qualify for a Class 1 exemption for existing facilities could be cited for the « addition of safety or health protection devices for use during construction of or in conjunction with existing structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, including navigational devices. » (CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(f).

Financing plan – The District anticipates a collaboration between private contributors, individual donations and Grant funded revenue sources. The preliminary budget to complete the project is **\$60,796.87** and anticipates (3) installations on government owned properties. The budget is determined with Industry quotes for a fixed or mounted outdoor warning system with battery backup, solar recharge capacity with power transfer switch and radio signal interface.

Federal funding requires prior listing from the Authorized Equipment Inventory list. FEMA Authorized Equipment List inventory :

Alert and Warning paired with Critical Messaging :

The activation of a ZENSS – Siren is only a piece of the puzzle. Discussion and reseach are currently focused on two fronts. First, community Multi-Use Radio Service (MURS) radio networks exist to provide essential messaging to the public in the event on an incident. Low power and short range radio networks can be established linking neighborhoods. Alternatively, research in underway into LoRa technology to link communities without power, cellular or wifi services. It utilizes a mesh network running on solar power or battery. Connects users via cellphone via bluetooth, wifi, usb plugin and requires a cell phone application similar to a messaging application. Key neighborhood linkage may be provided through existing networks of « Firewise » communities currently established within the greater community. These relationships can be leveraged to build on existing neighborhood familiarity and common bonds.

Siren Saturday's – Monthly testing of the Zayante Emergency Notificiation Siren System (ZENSS) will occur on the first Saturday of each month at 11am. The purpose of monthly testing is to ensure that the siren is functioning and to increase awareness of the importance of personal emergency preparedness, registration in Public Alerting platforms and to condition public response.
